These homework activities are things you can do at home to support your learning. They are quick activities, which should only take between 10 and 15 minutes each. Have fun with them.

Homework week beginning 10th January 2022

Listen to a bedtime story every night. Remember to look at the pictures and talk about them.

We are reading a story called Owl Babies. Can you draw a picture of your favourite part of the story, and tell an adult about it? Remember to include the wings, beaks and claws on the owl, and think about what the owl house looks like.

We are learning to count down from 20. Can you practise chanting the numbers from 20 to 0. You could use funny voices, or even blast off when you get to zero.

The weather has been very changeable recently. Maybe we should keep a weather diary this week.

When you wake up in the morning, look out of the window. What is the weather like today? Is it windy? Is it sunny? Is it foggy? Is it raining? Talk to an adult about what you think the weather is like today. Maybe you could draw a simple picture to represent the day's weather.

Do this for every day of the week. Has the weather been the same every day, or has it changed?
