These homework activities are things you can do at home to support your learning. They are quick activities, which should only take between 10 and 15 minutes each. Have fun with them.

Homework week beginning 23rd May 2022

Listen to a bedtime story every night. Remember to look at the pictures and talk about them.

We are reading a book about growing sunflowers.

Can you draw the different stages of the process of drawing a sunflower? What do you have to do first/ next/ after that?

Draw a picture of what your sunflower will look like when it is fully grown.

Write a sentence about it, eg, 'It will be.....'

We are thinking about some common 2D shapes: circle, triangle, square and rectangle.

Can you find any of these shapes in your house? How many sides do they have? How many corners?

We have been writing instructions about how to plant sunflowers. On Thursday, a sunflower kit will be coming home. Could you plant your sunflower seed, using the instructions? Don't worry if it grows too big! You can always send it back once it has got going, and we will find a big space for it in our garden. Or if you are lucky enough to have a balcony or garden, you could plant it outside in the future, and watch it grow really tall.
