These homework activities are things you can do at home to support your learning. They are quick activities, which should only take between 10 and 15 minutes each. Have fun with them.

Homework week beginning 24th January 2022

Listen to a bedtime story every night. Remember to look at the pictures and talk about them.

We are showing great progress with our writing. This week, we are going to write a sentence about what we can do. The sentence should start 'I can.....'. children should then use their sounds to write what they can do. Remember, at this stage, they may only be able to write the beginning, middle and end sounds. Work with them at the writing stage they are at, and remember to praise effort.

If your child is an enthusiastic writer, they might want to write an 'I can....' book, with a sentence on each page.

Help your children to draw around their hands. Can they label the fingers from 1 - 10. Support them to do this as necessary, because number formation can be quite tricky.

Before attempting the above writing activity, and as the week goes on, encourage your child to talk about what they are good at. Particularly, about things they have improved at. For example, 'When I was little, I couldn't put my coat on, but now I can do it by myself.'
