These homework activities are things you can do at home to support your learning. They are quick activities, which should only take between 10 and 15 minutes each. Have fun with them.

Homework week beginning 6th December 2021

Listen to a bedtime story every night. Remember to look at the pictures and talk about them.

It is nearly Christmas time. Have you written your Christmas list yet?

Remember to write the toys you are wishing for one under another. Draw a picture of the toy, then write the initial sound of it if you can, or all of the sounds that you can hear.

Put your name on your list so that Santa knows it is from you.

Have you ever made paper chains? Maybe you could make some for your house. You could make your paper chains in a pattern, for example, yellow, blue, yellow, blue.

If this is too easy for you, why not try a three colour pattern?

Why not make your own Christmas decoration?

Here is the recipe for salt dough:

1 cup of flour

1 cup of salt

1 ½ cups of water

Mix all of the ingredients together until they make a stiff dough.

Remember to do the measuring and the mixing yourself.

Now you can make your decoration. It could be a snowman, or a star, or a fairy.

Make sure you make a hole at the top for the string to go through!

Now bake your decoration on a medium heat for about an hour.

When it is cool, you can paint it and hang it on your tree, or over your door.
