- **Set Time Limits**: Establish clear rules regarding the amount of time your child can spend playing online games. Children's mental health and concentration at school can become affected when they spend too long playing online games.
- Monitor Game Content: Regularly review the content of the games your child plays to ensure it aligns with your family's values.
