- Although there is 10% difference in the % of children attaining the expected standard in reading, the Pupil Premium children made more rapid progress from their attainment at KS1 (4.3 compared to 3.0)
- Although there is a very slight difference in the % of children attaining the expected standard in reading (maintained form last year), and no Pupil premium child was considered to be higher attaining in maths the Pupil Premium children made more rapid progress from their attainment at KS1 (2.7 compared to 1.9)
- We have diminished the difference in the % of children attaining at the higher level in reading
- There is a slight difference in the progress scores in writing but the pupil premium made more progress than their non-pupil premium peers in both reading and maths.

- In the combined measure the difference has been diminished slightly all children's rose by 6% and the pupil premium children's rose by 7%;
- None of the pupil premium children attaining the higher combined measure this year. This will be a target for next year.

- The % of children attaining the required standard in the phonics screening test fell this year. This was the cohort that had the lowest % of GLD in the LA. To reach 72% represents good progress.
- There is a gap in attainment this year but this is not a trend, as can be seen from 2017's results. There were 13 children PP children in 2018's cohort, many of whom had other complex needs.
