

## St Agnes School Uniform

*Summer Uniform can be worn from the beginning of the Summer Term until Autumn Half term. No polo shirts are to be worn at any other time.*

<b>Winter</b> Navy Sweatshirt, Jumper or Cardigan White blouse Navy Skirt or Pinafore Navy Trousers - They must be proper school trousers not stretchy or tracksuit bottoms Tie Black Shoes -flat (NO BOOTS, NO BLACK TRAINERS) Navy or Black Tights / white socks plain	<b>Summer</b> Blue Gingham or Stripe Dress (Rec-Y6) White Polo Shirt (optional for Year 6) Navy Skirt (Optional for Year 6) Navy Sweatshirt or Cardigan White socks
<b>Boys</b>	
<b>Winter</b> Navy Sweatshirt or Jumper Grey Trousers White Shirt with a tie Tie Black, Navy or Grey socks (plain) Black Shoes (NO BOOTS, NO BLACK TRAINERS)	<b>Summer</b> White School Polo Shirt Grey Trousers or Shorts Short Sleeved Shirts may be worn – white with tie
<b>Hair Accessories</b>	
Small, plain blue or white hair bands or hair toggles only. Long hair should be worn up. No patterned hair cuts. No large bows – even if blue or white.	
<b>P.E. Kit for Boys and Girls (must be in a school P.E. bag)</b>	
School Navy/Plain White T-Shirt Navy Shorts or plain tracksuit in cold weather School Baseball Cap (optional) Black Plimsolls (only Y6 can wear trainers)	<b>Sporting Events</b> When representing the school children should wear the school PE kit unless otherwise directed.
<b>Swimming (Y4-Y6)</b>	
<b>Girls</b> Swimming costume (no bikinis allowed) Swimming cap (without a cap they will not be allowed in the water) Towel Special sock if child has verucca	<b>Boys</b> Swimming trunks (no swimming shorts allowed) Swimming cap (without a cap they will not be allowed in the water) Towel Special sock if child has verucca

Please do not send your child to school wearing jewellery or nail varnish. Children from Y2 up can wear a watch but it should be analogue – nothing that can link to the internet. If lost it is their responsibility. Earrings of any description may not be worn. Parents will be asked to remove earrings immediately.

Children are not allowed to bring money, toys, fidget spinners, food or drink to school unless specifically asked to do so.

Only Y6 may bring mobile phones to school but they must be placed in the office straight away. Y6 phones are to be switched off and put away once on school grounds.
