Choose from a selection of challenges on the menu to test your Maths skills. Everything involved in this challenge includes the number 2.

Start with any number, double it... and keep doubling! How high can you go?	Pay for something at the shops with only 2ps, 20ps and £2 coins.	How high can you count in 2s? How quickly can you do it?
Go on TT Rock Stars for 2 hours between 2.2.22-22.2.22	Write the 2 x times tables as high as you can go!	How many square numbers can you find (to the power of 2)?
How many 2s can you find in real world contexts (e.g. door numbers, signs, items in groups of 2). Be creative with what you can find and how you present it!	Problem solving 'Four Twos' Use four 2s and any/or all of the operations. What values can you make?	What quantities and items can you half during this week?
