<p>Please encourage your child to read their reading book independently. Look at the letter sounds/ words on the inside of the front cover first before reading the book. The children should use their letter sounds to help them to read as these are the sounds we have practised so far. They should say the word after sounding it out.</p> <p>When they do, please read for <b>15 minutes</b> every day. We will change books every Monday and Thursday.</p> <p>Read every night and please sign the reading record once your child has read.</p>	<p>This is our word of the week.
